A Christian perspective on Easter

Christians celebrate Easter because they believe that Jesus Christ was resurrected three days after his execution, his crucifixion on Good Friday.

How we demonstrate Easter as a school community

In the period of Lent, we take part in the ritual of being Ashed. On Ash Wednesday Pupils are encouraged to observe Lent in one of two ways – making a sacrifice or entering a period of abstinence for the period of lent, or observing a Lent challenge or reflection.

Questions to consider as a school community

How can we support those in our community who are unable to participate in Easter? How can we support those families or those who are vulnerable during the Lentern period?
