What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres?	29/32 pupils – 90.6% Reception – Year 6 = 1 pupil Pupils joined in Year 4 and 5 = 2

What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	31/32 Pupils = 96.9%
