of the rule


3rd warning – work alone & miss 5 minutes of break or lunch 4th warning – sent to SLT

# Types of Behaviour



### Behaviour Types

### Flourishing

Showing one or more of our Values in Action. Having resilience and persevering through a challenge.



#### Level 1

Making great choices. Doing the right thing. Work that shows great effort



### Level 2

Making good choices. Showing a positive attitude. Listening to others.



### Level 3

Name calling, calling out in class/disrupting the learning/ not following staff instructions/

Disrespect to an adult - low level



#### Level 4

Pushing and shoving (low level) e.g. lining up and finding it hard to understand personal space, being dishonest



**EPOMS** 

Bullying, including cyber bullying, aggressive behaviour, swearing, rude gesturing, verbal abuse, leaving class without permission.



### Level 6

Putting self or others in danger, damaging/defacing school property, throwing objects, abusive/obscene language, threats, petty theft (e.g., pencils, rulers etc.), biting, minor assault. Fighting and violence, Racist and homophobic incident, sexualised behaviours.

### Safeguarding Behaviour

#### Level 4

Pushing and shoving (low level) e.g. lining up and finding it hard to understand personal space, being dishonest

SLT to monitor reflection time sheets and record in behaviour file

Class teacher to speak to parents

### SLT

A portion of break / lunchtime for reflective conversation (Dependent on SEND and individual children's needs – year group and age) Record on Reflection Sheet

Staff to record on **©POMS** 

SLT member to speak to parents

#### Internal Isolation

Incident brought to the headteacher. HT or SLT and staff to gather evidence.

- Consequence: time in Internal isolation completing work appropriate to behaviour, children's age and any SEND requirements
- A period on behaviour monitoring agreed to see improvement
- Reflective session with the child & and recorded in behaviour book
- Support put into place to support child with restorative support. Staff to record on CPOMS

HT or SLT member to call parents or speak Face-to face to discuss restorative practise and a way forwards.

### Level 5

Bullying, including cyber bullying, aggressive behaviour, swearing, rude gesturing, verbal abuse, leaving class without permission. Staff: A portion of lunch missed for reflective conversation(Dependent on SEND and individual children's needs – year group a CPOMS aff to record on

SLT member to use reflection time script and record in behaviour book

Class teacher and SLT member to speak to parents

### Internal Isolation

Incident brought to the headteacher. HT or SLT and staff to gather evidence.

Consequence: time in Internal isolation completing work appropriate to behaviour, children's age and any SEND requirements

- A period on behaviour monitoring agreed to see improvement
- Reflective session with the child & and recorded in behaviour book
- Support put into place to support child with restorative support.

Staff to record on CPOMS

HT or SLT to call parents or speak Face-to face to discuss restorative.
practise and a way forwards.

### Fixed term suspension

Action: HT and staff to gather evidence Consequences:

- Fixed term suspension appropriate to behaviour and children's age
- •External support put in place e.g. the PRU
- •Risk assessment and management plan and positive behaviour management plan created
- •HT to have a reintegration meeting with parents to discuss restorative practise, Risk Assessment, management and positive behaviour plan
- •School letter sent home
- Local authority notified

**CPOMS** 

### Level 6

Putting self or others in danger, damaging/defacing school property, throwing objects, abusive/obscene language, threats, petty theft (e.g., pencils, rulers etc.), biting, minor assault. Fighting and violence, Racist and homophobic incident, sexualised behaviours.

### Internal Isolation

Action: incident brought to the headteacher.

HT and staff to gather evidence.

### Consequence:

- Time in Internal isolation completing work appropriate to behaviour, children's age and any SEND requirements
- A period on behaviour monitoring agreed to see improvement
- •HT to call parents or speak face to face
- •Record on **©POMS**

### Action Fixed Term Suspension:

HT and staff to gather evidence Incident logged on CPOMS

Consequence: fixed term suspension appropriate to behaviour and children's age

- External support put in place e.g. the PRU
- Risk assessment and management plan and positive behaviour management plan created
- HT to have a reintegration meeting with parents School letter sent home
- Local authority notified

### Fixed Term Exclusion or Permanent Exclusion:

This depends on the nature of the incident advice from the Exclusions Team and the ODBST Trust will be sought by the headteacher HT and staff to gather evidence

Consequence: fixed term suspension appropriate to behaviour and children's age

- External support put in place e.g. the PRU
- Risk assessment and management plan and positive behaviour management plan update (if appropriate)
- HT to have a reintegration meeting with parents School letter sent home. Local authority notified.
