Key Skills Taught

Enquire and Explore

- Investigate who Jesus was from the gospels about his birth.
- Investigate the different gifts that the Magi brought to Jesus and their significance for the life of Jesus.
- Investigate what was prophesied in the Old Testament about the Messiah.
- Explore the different symbols associated with Christmas and focus on the Christian symbols.
- Explore baptism and the different types of baptisms different churches practise.
- Learn about the baptism of Jesus by John and why Jesus got baptised.

Key Skills Taught

Evaluate

- Consider if Jesus was a gift. Why was Jesus born?
- Consider the different names given to Jesus.
- Consider why people get baptised.

Reflect and Communicate

- Reflect on and compare what Christians and non-Christians celebrate at Christmas.
- What would you say if you had to describe the true meaning of Christmas for yourself and why?



Key Knowledge Taught: *by the end of the unit pupils are expected to be able to:*

- Recall the key events of Jesus' birth.
- List some of the names of Jesus found in the gospel accounts about his birth and can explain some in their own words.
- Describe the key symbols of Christmas and explain the meaning behind those in simple terms.
- Describe the artefacts used in a baptism service.
- Link some Christian beliefs with the symbols and artefacts connected with baptism.
