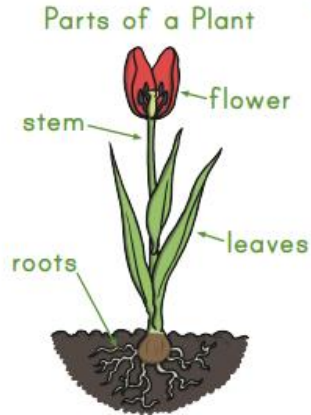

| deciduous | A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year. |
| evergreen | An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves |

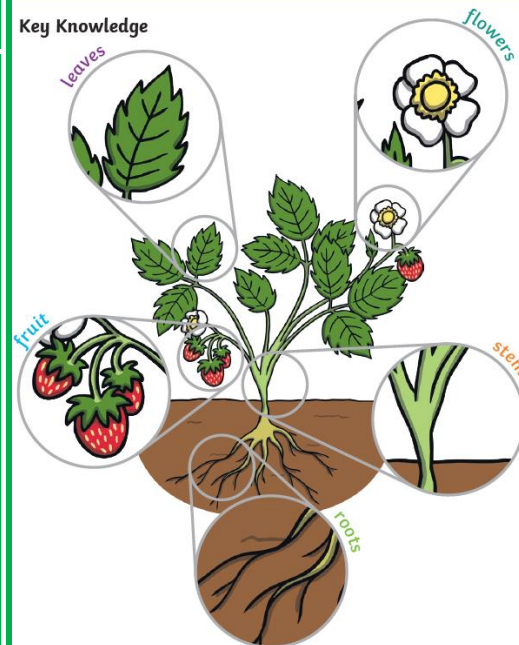
